



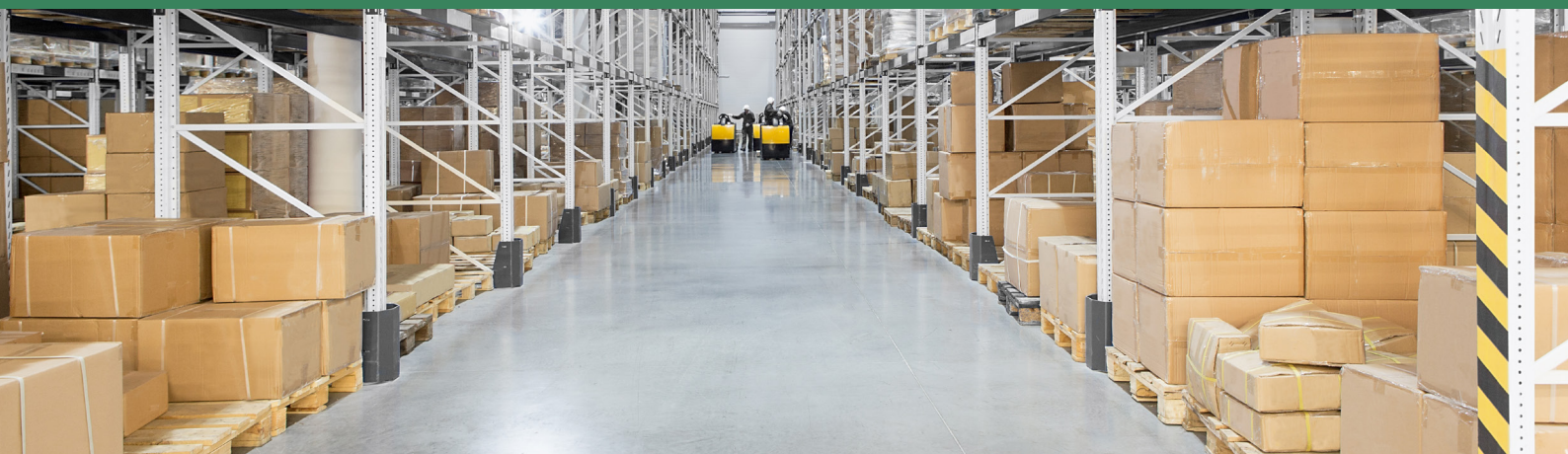
THE BENEFITS OF A TRANSITION FROM

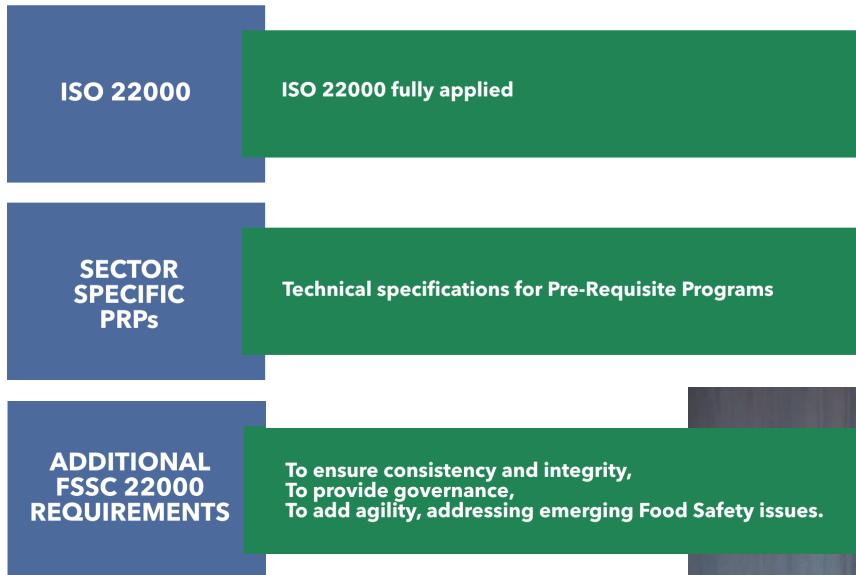
ACCESS TO INTERNATIONAL MARKETS

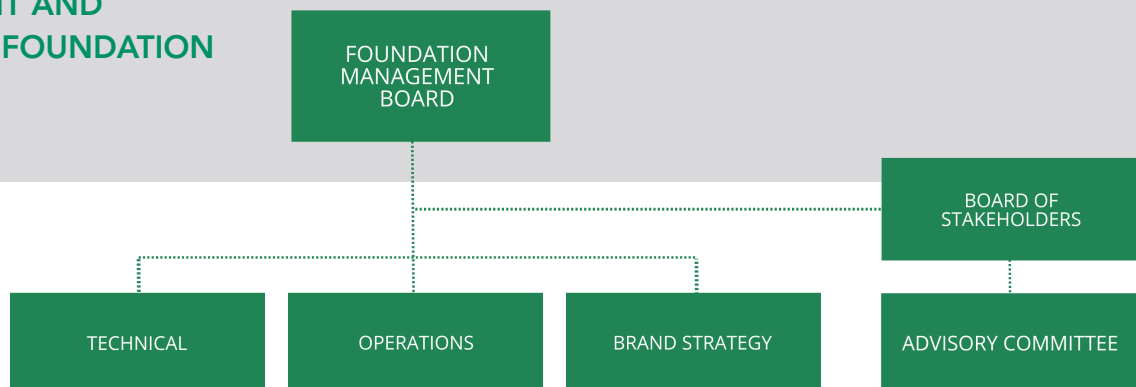
STRUCTURE OF FSSC 22000

HOW TO BECOME FSSC 22000 CERTIFIED

As an ISO 22000 certified organization, it is a relatively small step towards FSSC 22000 certification, depending on your current management system's content and implementation level. With a gap analysis, you can identify any missing elements.

Are you interested in becoming FSSC 22000 certified and getting the full value of your food safety management system? Then follow these steps to begin the transition process:

- 1** Get information on the FSSC 22000 requirements. Alongside the generic ISO 22000 requirements, you need to select the appropriate ISO technical specification (ISO/TS 22002-x or PAS 221) covering the prerequisite program requirements for your sector and the additional FSSC 22000 requirements specified in Part 2 of the FSSC 22000 Scheme documents.
- 2** Perform a gap analysis against the applicable FSSC 22000 requirements. A gap analysis is not mandatory but will support you in identifying and closing any gaps in your system.
- 3** Select a licensed certification body from the list available on our website. You can also see the (sub)categories they are approved for and in which countries they operate.
- 4** Request that the Certification Body provides an FSSC 22000 certification audit proposal.
- 5** The Certification Body can inform you of all the details of the delivery of the FSSC 22000 certification audit and subsequent annual surveillance audits for a complete certification cycle of 3 years. The additional time required from the ISO 22000 audit is minimal compared to the benefits FSSC 22000 can bring.

So, why not push forward, achieve FSSC 22000 certification and maximize the value? It is the most efficient way to proceed from ISO 22000 to a GFSI recognized scheme.
